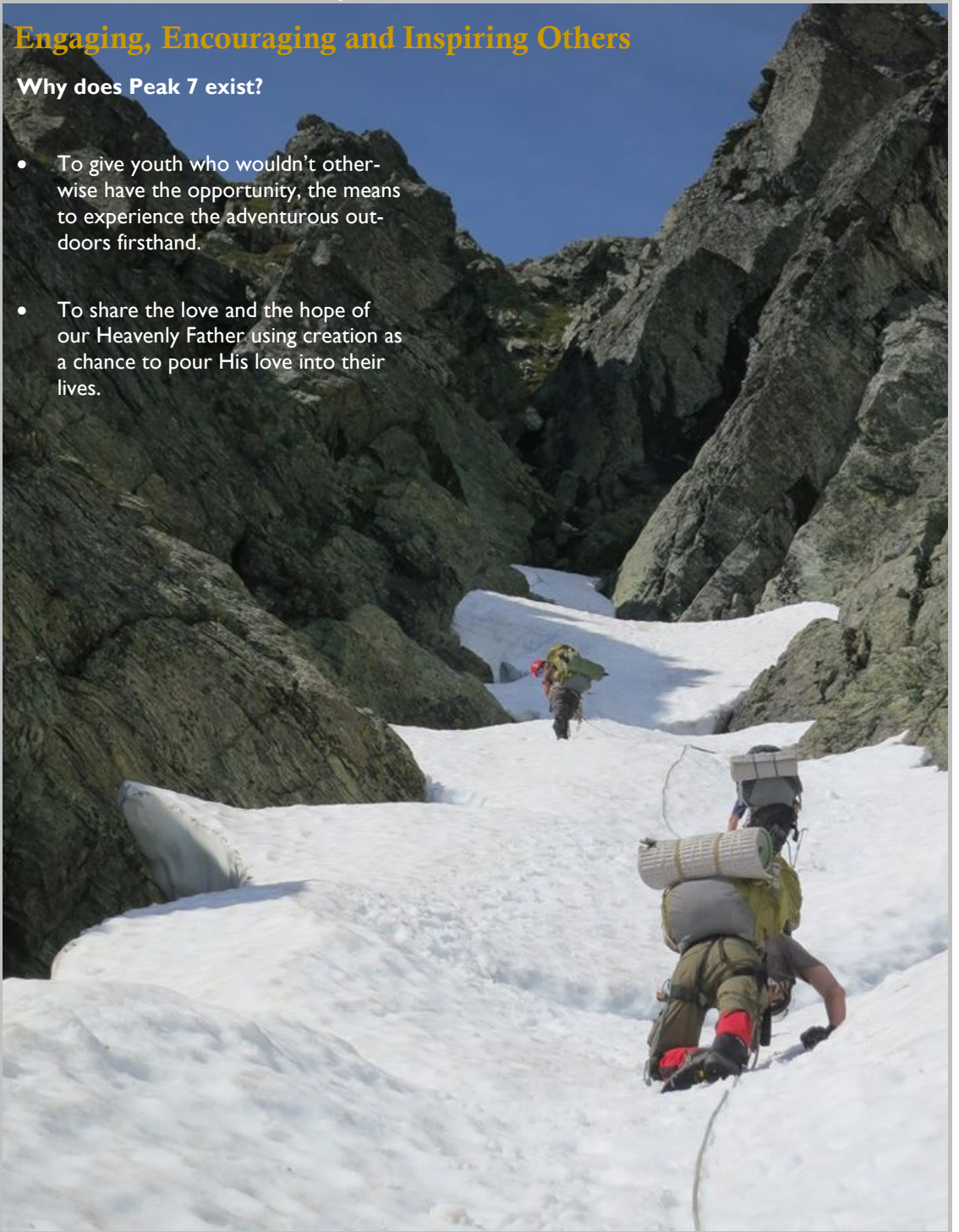

Peak 7 Adventures

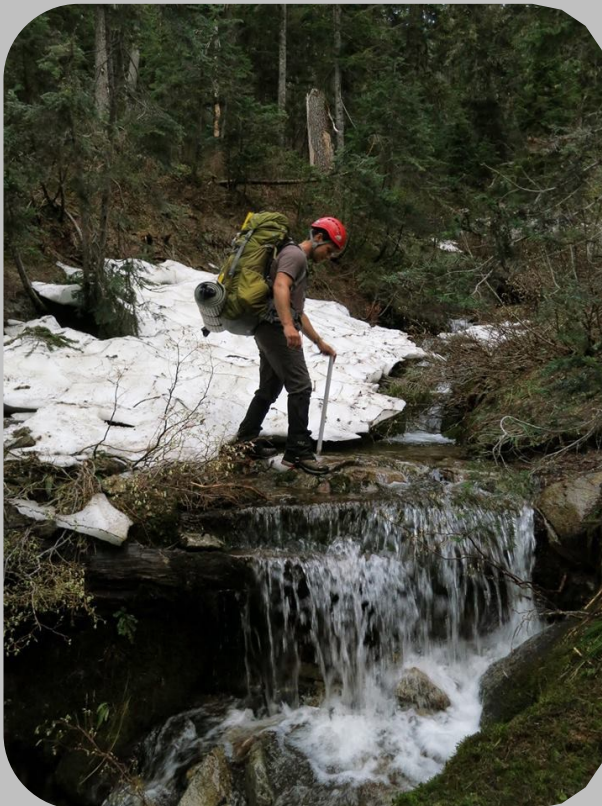

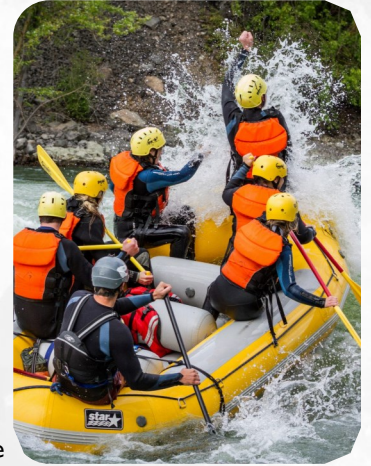
ADVENTURE PROGRAMS Impacting Lives

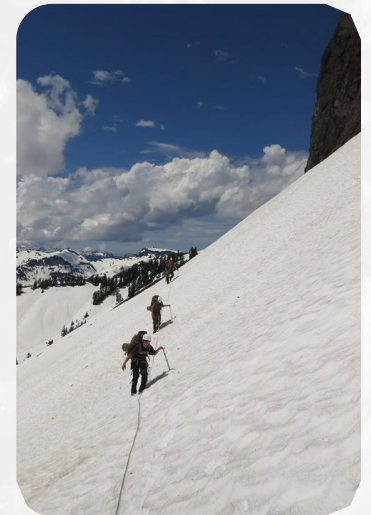
- Peak 7 is currently seeking donors who are interested in contributing in various ways:

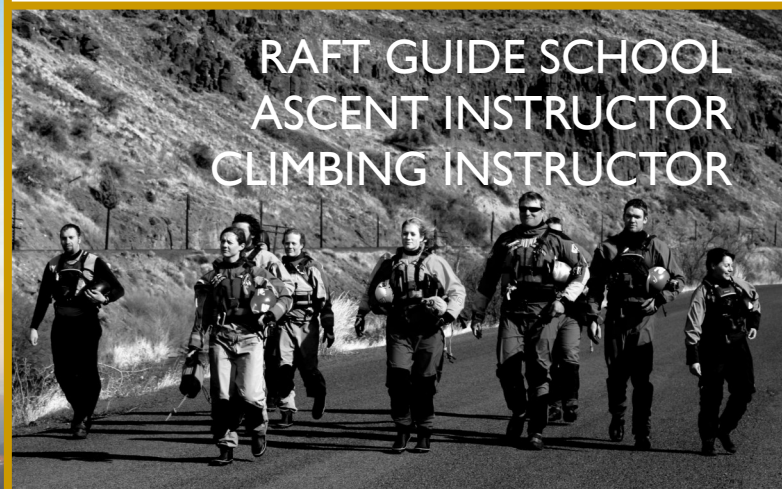

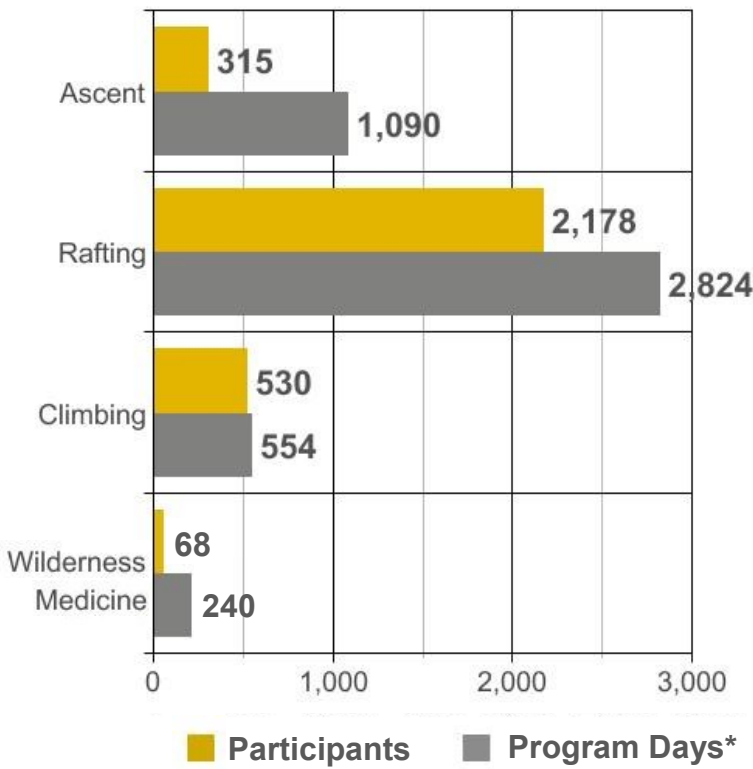

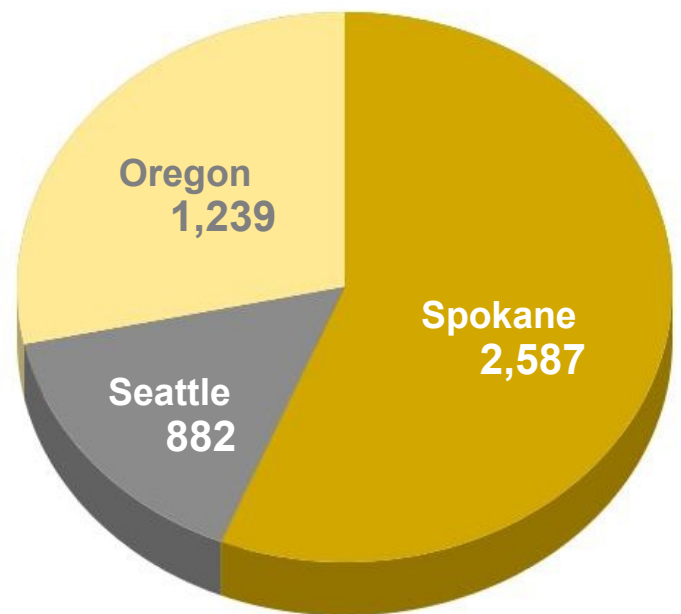

Participant Breakdown by Program

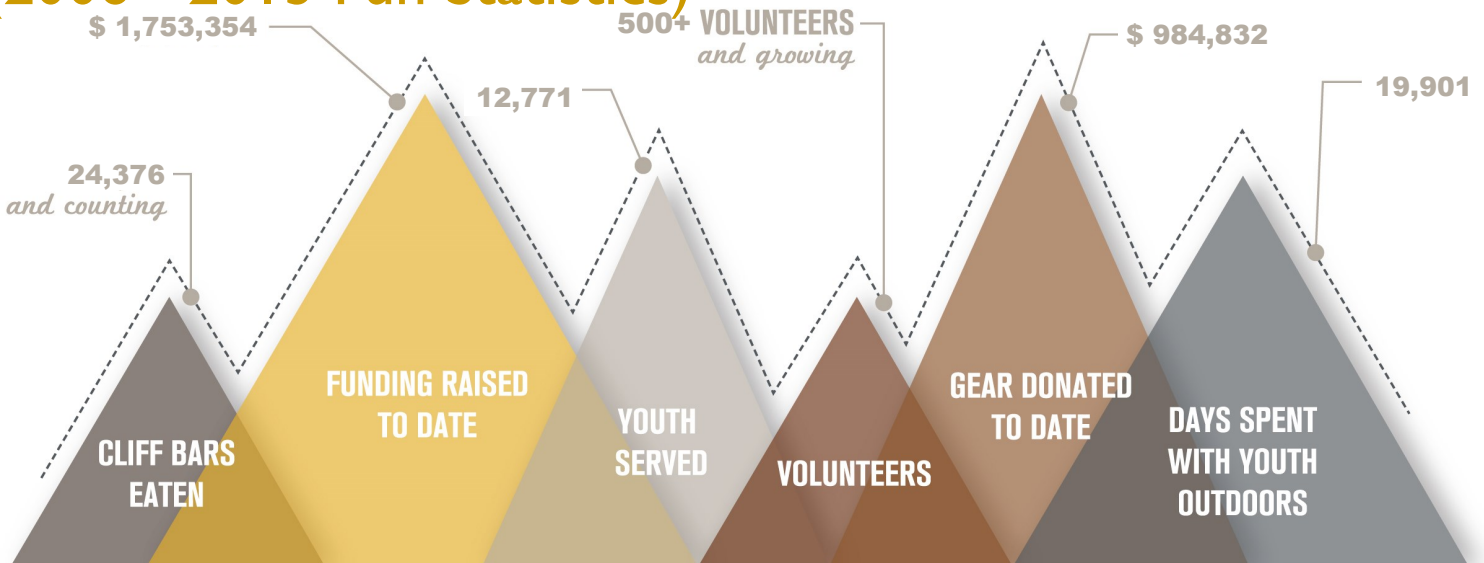


Program Days* by Region

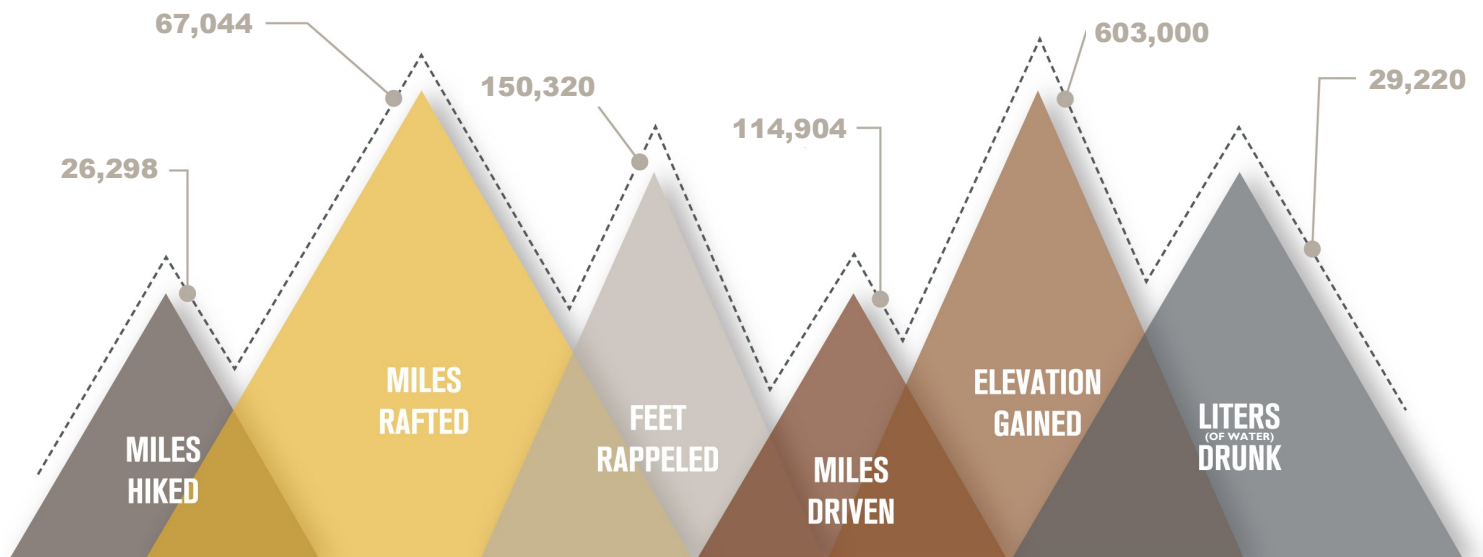

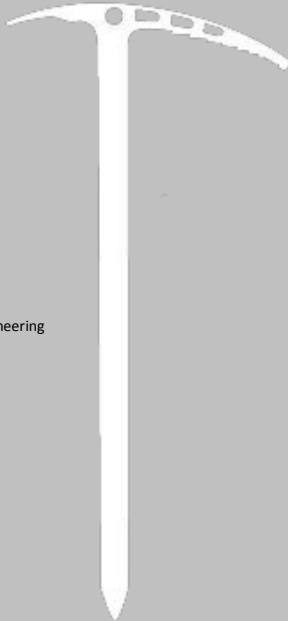
