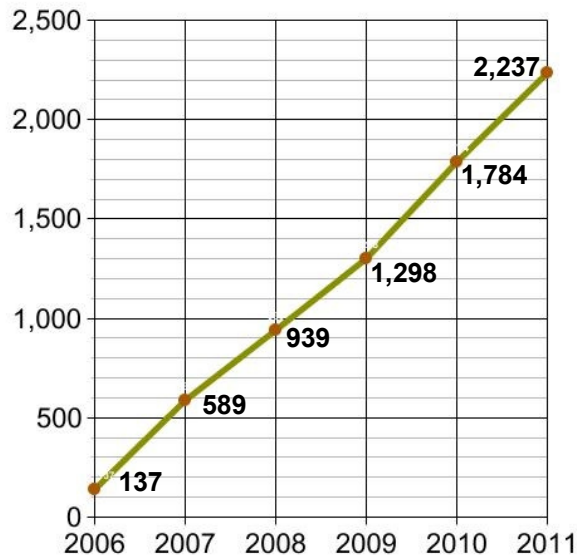

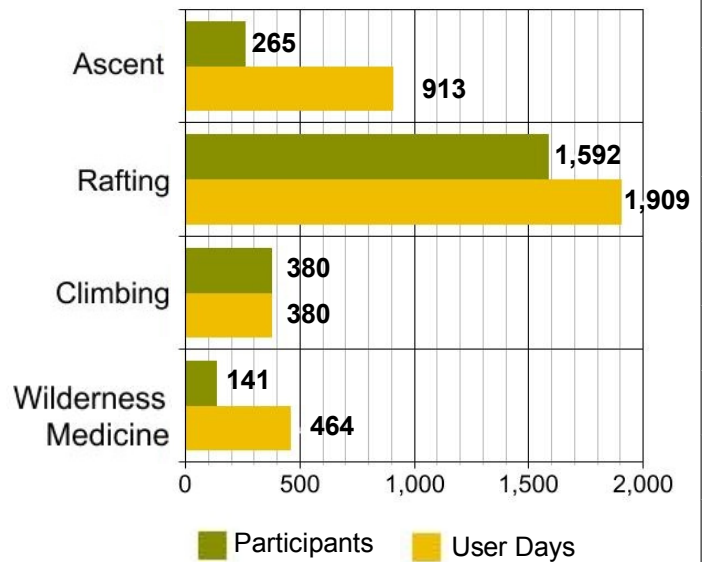

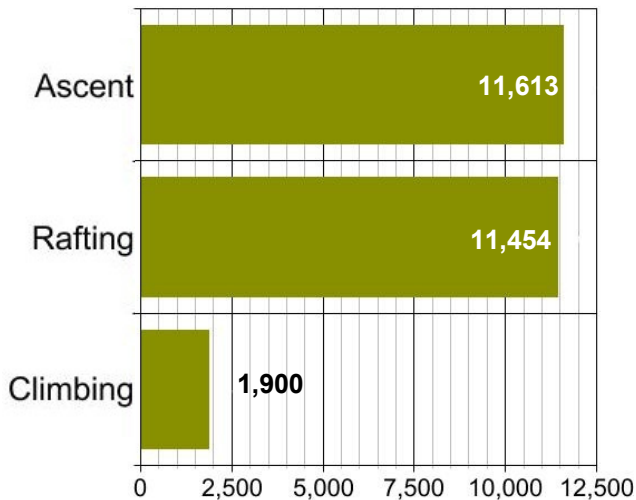
NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS



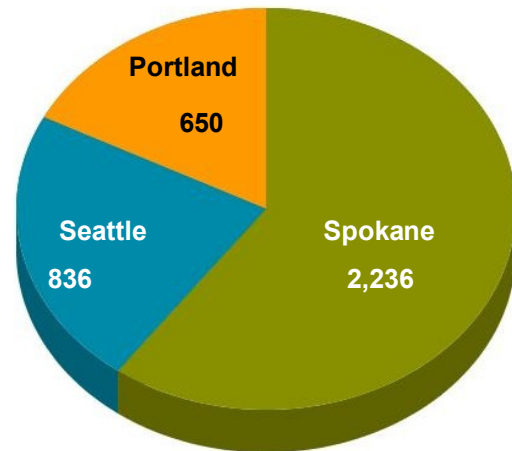
PARTICIPANT # AND USER DAY # BREAKDOWN
